PROPOSITION 105 (STATUTORY)
Shall there be a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes concerning labeling of genetically modified food; and, in connection therewith, requiring food that has been genetically modified or treated with genetically modified material to be labeled, "Produced With Genetically Modified Material" starting on July 1, 2016; excepting some foods including but not limited to food from animals that are not genetically modified but have been fed or injected with genetically modified food or drugs, certain food that is not packaged for retail sale and is intended for immediate human consumption, alcoholic beverages, food for animals, and medically prescribed food; requiring the Colorado department of public health and environment to regulate the labeling of genetically modified food; and specifying that no private right of action is created for failure to conform to the labeling requirements?

SHALL THE CLATHE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$226,347 IN TAX COLLECTION YEAR 2015, AND BY SUCH AMOUNTS THAT ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER BY THE IMPOSITION OF AN ADDITIONAL 4.5 MILLS AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX, WHICH, TOGETHER WITH OTHER DISTRICT TAX LEVIES FOR OPERATING PURPOSES, SHALL NOT EXCEED A TOTAL OF 9.016 MILLS IN ANY FISCAL YEAR, FOR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND ASSOCIATED EXPENSES FOR PERSONNEL TO PROVIDE FIRE, RESCUE, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES; AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAXES AND INVESTMENT EARNINGS THEREON BE COLLECTED AND SPENT WITHOUT LIMITATION OR CONDITION, AND WITHOUT LIMITING THE COLLECTION OR SPENDING OF ANY OTHER DISTRICT REVENUES OR FUNDS UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, OR ANY OTHER LAW; AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAXES BE COLLECTED AND SPENT ANNUALLY REGARDLESS OF THE ANNUAL 5.5% PROPERTY TAX REVENUE LIMITATION SET FORTH IN SECTION 29-1-301 OF COLORADO REVISED STATUTES OR ANY OTHER LAW?
