BALLOT ISSUE 2A

WITHOUT AN INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAX, OR, THE SALES TAX RATE, SHALL THE TOWN OF NATURITA, COLORADO, BE ALLOWED AN ADDITIONAL 1% SALES AND USE TAX, COLLECTED ON AUTOMOBILES AND CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS, BRINGING THE SALES AND USE TAX TO A 4% UNIFORM RATE, BEGINNING IN 2008, WHICH WILL BE THE FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR OF INCREASE, AND BY WHATEVER ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, BY APPROVAL OF THE VOTERS OF ORDINANCE NO. 222, SALES AND USE TAX WOULD BE INCREASED BY 1%. THE ALLOCATION, IF APPROVED BY THE VOTERS, SHALL BE SALES AND USE TAX TO OPERATIONS OF THE TOWN AND 100% OF THE SALES AND USE TAX SHALL BE DEDICATED TO TOWN INFRASTRUCTURE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO: ROADS, STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS, CURBS, GUTTERS, DRAINAGE, UTILITIES AND RELATED EQUIPMENT AND APPURTENANCES, AND SHALL THE TOWN OF NATURITA, COLORADO, BE PERMITTED TO COLLECT, RETAIN AND SPEND THE FULL PROCEEDS OF THE TOWN'S SALES AND USE TAX, INCLUDING INTEREST EARNED THEREON, NOTWITHSTANDING ANY STATE RESTRICTIONS ON FISCAL YEAR SPENDING, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION THE RESTRICTIONS OF ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, TABOR (TAXPAYERS BILL OF RIGHTS)?

SHALL NORWOOD SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. R-2J TAXES BE INCREASED UP TO \$350,000, ADJUSTED FOR INFLATION, FOR PURPOSE OF ATTRACTING AND RETAINING QUALIFIED TEACHERS AND STAFF, AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR ESSENTIAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES, BY AN ADDITIONAL PROPERTY TAX LEVY THAT RESULTS IN THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUES SET FORTH ABOVE IN THE CURRENT BUDGET YEAR AND THE SAME DOLLAR AMOUNT, ADJUSTED ANNUALLY IN EACH BUDGET YEAR THEREAFTER FOR INFLATION AS MEASURED BY THE DENVER-BOULDER-GREELEY CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, WHICH TAXES SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE DISTRICT, SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO THE PROPERTY TAXES THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE LEVIED FOR THE GENERAL FUND AND SHALL CONSTITUTE A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE?

SHALL MONTROSE RECREATION DISTRICT DEBT BE INCREASED UP TO \$5,000,000, WITH A MAXIMUM REPAYMENT COST OF UP TO \$6,895,000, AND SHALL DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED UP TO \$585,000 ANNUALLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, REMODELING, AND MAKING ADDITIONS TO THE AQUATIC CENTER WHICH MAY INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING: CONSTRUCTING MULTIPURPOSE PROGRAMMABLE SPACES TO INCLUDE CLASSROOM(S), MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM(S), GYMNASIUM(S), AND A SUSPENDED WALKING/JOGGING TRACK; CONSTRUCTING AUXILIARY SERVICE AREAS INCLUDING LOBBY, FRONT DESK, STORAGE AREAS, AND BATHROOMS; AND REMODELING THE EXISTING FACILITY TO CONVERT THE UPSTAIRS BALCONY TO A FITNESS EXERCISE AREA, TO MODIFY THE WOMEN'S LOCKER-ROOM LAYOUT TO ALLOW FOR FAMILY CHANGING ROOM(S), AND TO CONVERT THE UPSTAIRS SPACE TO OFFICES, WORKROOM, AND A KITCHENETTE; SUCH DEBT TO CONSIST OF THE ISSUANCE AND PAYMENT OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, WHICH BONDS SHALL BEAR INTEREST AT A MAXIMUM NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE NOT TO EXCEED 5.85% PER ANNUM, SHALL MATURE NOT LATER THAN THIRTEEN YEARS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS, AND SHALL BE ISSUED, DATED AND SOLD AT SUCH TIME OR TIMES, AT SUCH PRICES (AT, ABOVE OR BELOW PAR) AND IN SUCH MANNER AND CONTAINING SUCH TERMS, NOT INCONSISTENT HERewith, AS THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MAY DETERMINE; SHALL AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES BE LEVIED IN ANY YEAR, WITHOUT LIMITATION AS TO RATE AND IN AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF, PREMIUM IF ANY, AND INTEREST ON SUCH BONDS AS THE SAME BECOME DUE; AND SHALL THE EARNINGS ON THE INVESTMENT OF THE REVENUES FROM SUCH TAXES AND THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH BONDS (REGARDLESS OF AMOUNT) CONSTITUTE A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE?
