BALLOT ISSUE 4A SHALL THE NORWOOD FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$113,741 ANNUALLY, OR BY SUCH AMOUNT AS MAY BE RAISED BY THE IMPOSITION OF AN ADDITIONAL AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX RATE OF UP TO 4.702 MILLS TO PROVIDE FIRE, RESCUE, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, RESULTING IN A TOTAL DISTRICT MILL LEVY RATE, EXCLUSIVE OF REFUNDS, ABATEMENTS, OR DEBT SERVICE, NOT TO EXCEED 10.6 MILLS, WHICH TOTAL RATE SHALL BE SET ANNUALLY AND MAY FLUCTUATE FROM YEAR TO YEAR, UP OR DOWN, WITHOUT ADDITIONAL VOTER APPROVAL, SO LONG AS THE TOTAL RATE DOES NOT EXCEED 10.6 MILLS, COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2016, AND CONTINUING THEREAFTER; AND SHALL THE DISTRICT BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN AND SPEND ALL TAX REVENUE COLLECTED FROM SUCH TOTAL PROPERTY TAX RATE, AND ALL OTHER REVENUE RECEIVED FROM ANY SOURCE, COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2015, AND CONTINUING THEREAFTER, AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, OFFSET AND EXCEPTION TO THE LIMITS WHICH WOULD OTHERWISE APPLY UNDER TABOR (ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION) OR ANY OTHER LAW AND AS A PERMANENT WAIVER OF THE 5.5% LIMITATION UNDER SECTION 29-1-301, C.R.S.
